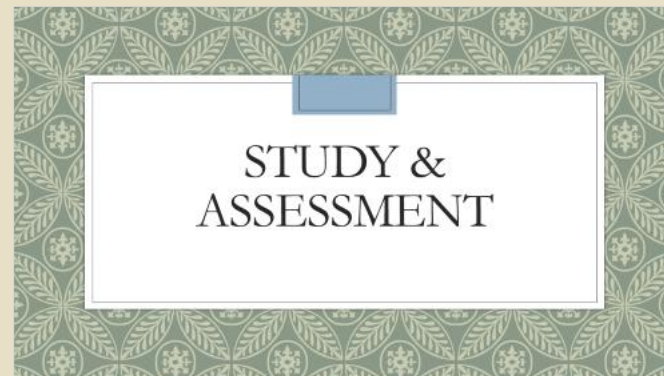
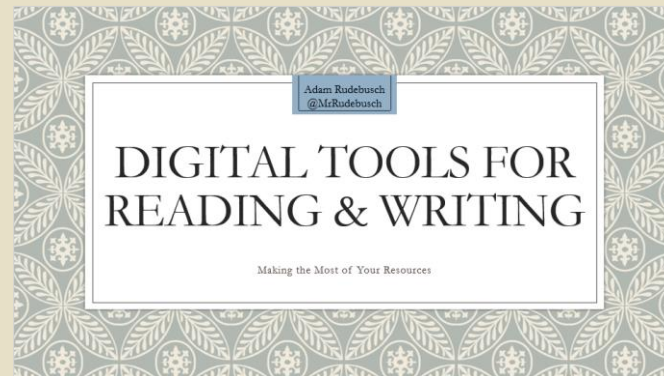

CONTENT & RESEARCH

South Dakota Library Databases

- Free to teachers and students subscribing to SD Library Services
- Specialized to particular subjects or areas of study
- Same databases that students will use in college

SIRS Issues Researcher

- Provides extensive list of controversial topics
 - Perfect for brainstorming/exploratory phase of writing
- Provides brief overview/summary of topic
- Breaks each topic down into two common stances
- Provides three articles aligned with or providing evidence supporting those two stances
- Provides many, many further articles for research upon topic

CommonLit

- Database of fiction, nonfiction, and poetry texts
- Organized by
 - Grade Level
 - Genre
 - Theme
 - Literary Device
- Comprehension Questions
- Evidence-based Textual Analysis Questions
- Students Can Highlight and Take Notes

Project Gutenberg

- VAST database of public domain works
- Printable
- HTML format allows for word-searching

FREE

MIT Shakespeare Resource

- Complete works of Shakespeare
- Whole-play or scene-by-scene indexes
- HTML format allows for word-searching

Folger Shakespeare Library



- Complete works of Shakespeare

- Online worksheet or test creator
- Instantly graded

Vocabulary.com

- Pre-compiled vocabulary lists by text
- Easy to create custom vocabulary lists
- Student practice modules
 - Variety of practices
 - Definition, Context, Antonym, Image, etc.
- Built in quizzes
- Instant grading
- Gamified review

Flipgrid

- Create custom prompts and assignments
 - Attach documents, images, videos (of you or other things)
- Make student videos private (only teacher can see each video) or public (so that students can see and respond to each other's)
- Teacher can respond by writing or video
- Customizable rubrics

Poll Everywhere

- Take instant survey
- Word cloud evolves with each new response
- Easy, visual way to assess popularity of particular responses

- Also helpful as teacher website platform.

Blogger

- Online journal/response tool
- Customizable
 - Backgrounds/themes for students to choose from
 - Permanent blogsite
- Easy to check quickly with Hapara or Google Classroom

FREE

Google Slides

- Works just like PowerPoint
- Students can collaborate on presentations at the same time

FREE

Prezi

- Interactive presentation tool
- Three Dimensional
- Ability to embed text, graphs, images, and video

Google Drawing

- Graphs & Diagrams
- Collages
 - Twelfth Night Character Poster
- Graphic Organizers
 - Greek Gods Family Tree
- Timelines
- Collaboration
 - Students (and teachers) can work on documents together, at the same time

 - Student Movie Poster

Venngage

- Create flowcharts and infographics
- Ready stock of clipart and templates

Google Docs

- All the capabilities of a basic word processing application
 - Documents
 - Worksheets
 - Tables
 - Commenting
- Collaboration
 - Students (and teachers) can work on documents together, at the same time
- Handy for syllabi
